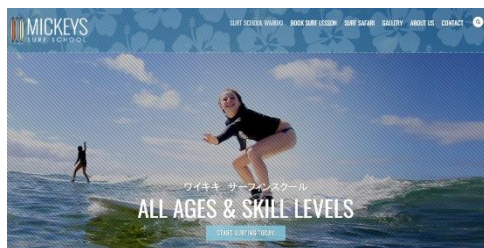

Important tips

For advanced reservations for the Arizona Memorial, visit: www.Recreation.gov. It is free to tour the Arizona Memorial. If you are not successful in securing reservations online for the ferry going over to the actual memorial, your other options are; arrive at the memorial before 530 am to stand in line for tickets or pay a tour company.

Hanauma Bay; Go early (630-730 am) or later in the afternoon around 130-2 pm. The crowd starts to get too much mid-day between 10 am-12 pm and because of its location protected by mountains, it gets very hot.

Try to schedule your circle island drive on the week-days. Break up the drive to consist of two days if possible. One day start from Waikiki and travel east ending your day at Kailua Town/Beach.

For a more scenic view, I suggest a drive to the N. Shore using the H-3 Highway.

Take a tour of China Town and downtown. Take a bus (\$2.50 one-way and if your excursion is less than 3 hours, keep the stub because the ride back is free!)

Pick-up a copy of the mid-week magazine from your front desk or concierge staff; great resource for local events.

Do try our local comfort food;

Poki; marinated ahi tuna, crab, squid or octopus. You can sample them at the local super market (Foodland) for free tasting

Lau Lau; Steamed in coconut milk wrapped in both taro (edible) tea leaf (non-edible). Pork, Chicken, squid or butter fish. My favorite!

Lomi Lomi Salmon; diced Hamakua red tomatoes, sweet Maui onions and smoked salmon and marinated in a light vinaigrette. Great over brown rice!

Looking for adventure? Pack a cooler (\$2 at ABC Store) with your favorite goodies and head for Kailua Beach. Make plans to rent a Kayak, paddle out to the Na Mokulua (Mok Island or translated; two islands) Islands. On the way over snorkel and swim with the fish and turtles. Have lunch at the two islands with monk seals basking on the beach. It is a 45 min. paddle out to the islands. Remember! You have to paddle back!
